Performers

4:40pm - 5:25pm Escort to stage, unpack, and set up

Performers and relevant staff will be escorted by Carlos Javier to the stage via the stage left gate. Tables will be provided to unpack and store cases. Performers are allowed to bring their instruments and sheet music. All other items are prohibited on stage.

Performers will be positioned on stage with the help of Stagehands. Audio personnel will adjust mic placements during this time. Performers should begin warming up as soon as they're ready to play.


5:30 - 5:55pm Performance

A GPMF Staff member will give a short introduction to the Young Artist Showcase and the performing group to the audience. Performance starts. We also ask a performer give a short welcome after the 1st work or before the last work.

After the performance and bows, performers are escorted back to the stage left tables to pack instruments. Performers must take their instruments, GPMF will not store instruments.

6:00pm Rejoined with family members

Performers are escorted to the "200" seating area with family members and are welcome to stay for the 6:30pm performance.
